CRITERIA

1. Attach a description of overall project type, scope, and project goals.
2. Attach a description of why your EIFS project is a “hero hidden in plain sight” and should be selected as the recipient of the EIFS Hero Award. Include project specific details on energy efficiency, design flexibility, code compliance, cost effectiveness, timely installation, and other attributes of exterior insulation and finish systems.

OPTIONAL:
 - a. Include a description of how choosing EIFS as the exterior wall cladding of the project (versus other claddings) was advantageous.
 - b. A testimonial from the project owner describing how the use of EIFS met the owner’s goals and expectations.
 - c. A testimonial from the project architect on why he/she chose EIFS as the cladding.
3. Submit at least 3, **but no more than 5**, high quality images (at least 300 dpi) of your project. Include a current photo if available. If more than 5 photos are submitted, only the first 5 will be viewed by the jury.

5. All entries must be received by November 30, 2019



TIPS FOR SUBMITTING A SUCCESSFUL ENTRY

- Pay close attention to the eligibility requirements and program criteria, especially project completion dates. Projects completed outside of the published dates will be deemed ineligible.
- Reach out to all members of the project team to assist with writing and submitting an entry. EIMA is not responsible for coordinating entries with project team members.
- Submit high quality, professional photography. Photography of the completed project is desirable, not the project under construction, unless you are submitting before and after photos. Make sure there is not construction equipment and/or debris in the photo. Interesting angles and up close shots of EIFS finishes are recommended. A sunny day with a blue sky in the background is optimum.
